- All groups/individuals wishing to enter the St Patricks Day Parade 2019 **must complete and return this form to the St. Patrick's Day Parade Organising Committee by 10th March 2019** by e-mail: info@feilebrianboru.com or by post. All floats/entries must make a contribution towards their entry in the 2019 Killaloe/Ballina St. Patrick's Day parade.
- All Floats/entries must be at the parade starting point - Ballina GAA Complex - by 1:45pm - **Parade commences at 2:30pm sharp.**
- All Floats/entries **must be fully insured** by the business/organisation. The organizing committee will not be held responsible for any accident or incident before, during or after the Parade events.
- Floats with performances must perform while moving through the streets – **for safety reasons there is no stopping during the parade or at the reviewing stand.**
- Sweets and other items **CANNOT** be thrown from vehicles – all sweets/free gifts for the public must be handed out by a person on foot. This person must be designated by the club/organisation.
- It is the responsibility of each float/entry **to nominate a group leader who will liaise with the parade organisers** to ensure the smooth continuous flow of the Parade. Each group leader must act on the advice given by the parade organisers.
