- All Floats/entries must be at the parade starting point Ballina GAA Complex by 1:45pm **Parade commences at 2:30pm sharp.**
- All Floats/entries **must be must be fully insured** by the business/organisation. The organizing committee will not be held responsible for any accident or incident before, during or after the Parade events.
- Floats with performances must perform while moving through the streets for safety reasons there is no stopping during the parade or at the reviewing stand.
- Sweets and other items <u>CANNOT</u> be thrown from vehicles all sweets/free gifts for the public must be handed out by a person on foot. This person must be designated by the club/organisation.
- It is the responsibility of each float/entry to nominate a group leader who will liaise with the parade organisers to ensure the smooth continuous flow of the Parade. Each group leader must act on the advice given by the parade organisers.
